Directions from **Turtle Bay** Resort – North Shore to Dillingham Airfield

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> The *overview* of these directions is: <u>Hwy 83</u> (Kamehameha Hwy) to <u>Hwy 930</u> to Waialua/<u>Mokuleia (Dillingham Airfield)</u> **Approximate drive-time = 55 minutes**

Get on Kamehameha Hwy (Hwy 83) going South and West.

Continue past Sunset Beach, past Pupukea (TRAFFIC SIGNAL), past Waimea Bay.

About 3 miles past Waimea Bay is the next TRAFFIC SIGNAL.

<u>If you turn right</u> at that signal, you will go THRU the town of HALEIWA ; and at the other end of town is a TRAFFIC CIRCLE (<u>counter</u>-clock-wise traffic).

If you go straight thru that 1st <u>Haleiwa</u> traffic signal, you will get to ANOTHER traffic-light in about 1.5 miles; and you will get into the RIGHT-HAND TURN LANE which will bring you into that same TRAFFIC-CIRCLE (<u>counter</u>-clock-wise traffic) AT THE OTHER END OF <u>HALEIWA</u>.

HUG THE CIRCLE .

One of the exits out of the traffic-circle indicates destination MOKULEIA / Hwy 930 <u>That's the direction you want</u>. You are now on the start of <u>Hwy 930</u>.

ABOUT 1 MILE BEYOND THE TRAFFIC CIRCLE is an INTERSECTION <u>4-WAY STOP</u>, red <u>blinker-light</u>.. This is the intersection of <u>Hwy 803</u> and <u>Hwy 930</u>.

TURN RIGHT after stopping at that intersection.

You are now continuing on Hwy 930.

Just for your information, <u>Hwy 930</u> starts at the TRAFFIC-CIRCLE at <u>Haleiwa</u>), and makes a 90-degree turn (to the West) at the blinker-light INTERSECTION, and continues out towards <u>Dillingham Airfield</u> and <u>Kaena Point</u>.

FROM THE <u>BLINKER-LIGHT</u> INTERSECTION, AFTER MAKING THE RIGHT-HAND TURN, continue ahead for about 1 mile.

You will see a ROAD-SIGN for

MOKULEIA, and DILLINGHAM AIRFIELD

These signs point towards the underpass of a bridge; ... go under the bridge.

You are still on <u>Hwy 930</u> (Farrington Hwy), ...continue ...

A half-block beyond the bridge, and on your left, is Waialua Intermediate & High School.

Continue about another 5 miles to the Airfield.

<u>Dillingham Airfield</u> is a 2-mile-long airstrip, parallel to the highway, with a green chain-link perimeter fence-line. There are 3 entrances to the Airfield. Entrance #1 is for the SKYDIVE activities (and the interior service-road for the airfield). Entrance #2 is 1.5 miles further, and THAT is the <u>Glider-port</u> entrance.

Asyouenter the GLIDER-PORT parking lot, there is an OPEN-SIDED SHELTER-BUILDING straight-ahead. This is the RECEPTION area. Ask for <u>Honolulu Soaring</u> / <u>The Original Glider Rides</u>, and <u>check in with "Mr. Bill"</u>.
